***Contents: what you will study***

You will be introduced to the GCSE syllabus and the initial Explorative Strategies and Elements of Drama that you will be using throughout the course. During the first half term you will explore non-naturalistic and abstract drama as well as semiotics in greater depth. For the second half term you will undertake a full scale Theatre-in-Education project with a target audience of primary school pupils.

***GCSE levels at which you will work***

Level A\* - G

***Skills which you will develop this term:***

You will mostly be developing your group skills in tasks designed to encourage a more abstract approach to drama work. You will also develop your skills in devising, acting, critiquing and technical support.

***Assessment: how you will be tested this term***

Your practical work will be monitored throughout the term and given a predicted GCSE grade at the end of it.
