In Art, Design and Technology, you have the opportunity to develop a range of skills and knowledge. You will follow a programme of study which includes Art, Textiles, Food and Resistant Materials.

***Contents: what you will study***

In Year 7 pupils are exploring the theme ‘ Myself ‘ in ADT and are taken on a transitional journey of how you feel coming from being at the top of their Primary School to now becoming the youngest in the Convent. Pupils start the course with group work getting to know each other.

***National Curriculum levels at which you will work***

You will be working at starting level 3B expecting to achieve level 4A – 5C by the end of year 7

***Skills which you will develop this year:***

Basic skills in textiles of hand-sewing, weaving, about fabric properties and structures and re-cycling materials, working on their own pieces.

You use a combination of all the skills that they are developing to design and make a fabric planner cover.

When complete, pupils learn how to use a sewing machine to stitch the product together.

***Assessment: how you will be tested this year***

You will be tested by verbal brainstorming in class, peer and self assessments and will be awarded levels and targets throughout the project.

***Equipment which you will need for this year’s work***

Pencils, coloured pencils, ruler, eraser, sharpener

***Key words which you will need to learn for this year’s work***

Stitching, hand sewing, weaving, fabric properties, fair-trade, fashion industry, layout
