Modules 1 and 2 (each containing 6 units) of your book *Listos 2*

Nos presentamos

In unit 1 you will learn to ask for, give and compare personal information.

In unit 2 you will learn to use adverbs to describe routine and free-time activities.

In unit 3 you will learn to introduce family members.

In unit 4 you will learn to ask for and say what you need.

In unit 5 you will learn to talk about buying gifts for people; describe personalities.

In unit 6/7 you will learn to write thank you letters. Understand personal information: introductory letters from penfriends.

In unit 1 you will learn to say what you eat and when.

In unit 6 you will learn to talk about healthy eating. Understand a longer text about Christmas in Spain.

National Curriculum levels at which you will work

Levels 3 - 4

Skills which you will develop this term:

Reading Short stories and factual texts and note some details, using context and dictionaries to deduce meaning

Writing paragraphs of 3 or 4 simple sentences from memorised language using grammar knowledge and dictionaries.

Listening to long passages of familiar language in simple sentences and identify main points and some details at normal speed but with repetition.

Speaking in simple, structured conversation of 3 or 4 exchanges using grammar to adapt and substitute single words and phrases and with a generally accurate pronunciation and intonation.

You will have a test at the end of term in listening, speaking, reading and writing.

In unit 5 you will learn to say what you did on holiday.

In unit 6 you will learn to say what other people did on holiday. Reading a diary entry about a trip to Cuba.
